Community Safety Tip

from the Yarramalong Rural Fire Brigade

The winter months are the most dangerous time of the year for house fires, with around 30% of all house fires occurring between the 1st of June and the 31st of August. An important step in preventing many of these fires, if you own a slow combustion or open fire place, is to make sure that your chimney is regularly cleaned at least every 12 months. Removal of built up, flammable carbon soot from within the chimney will not only reduce the risk of fire, but also help to improve the efficiency of your fire place. Always remember to place a screen in front of your fireplace when in use, and when drying clothing and other flammable materials make sure they are at least 1m away and never left unattended. Take care to store matches and lighters in a secure place, not accessible to children, and in the event of a fire, always call 000.

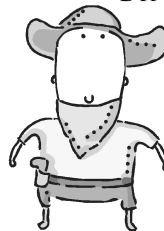
